First selection process (10 start-ups): the selection committee -which includes the members of Transfiere advisory board for investment promotion- will select 10 start-ups, 5 Spanish and 5 international (non-Spanish). The communication of the selected start-ups will be done on the 5th Apr 2021.

Second selection process (1 awarded start-up): At the end of the pitching session, the audience will select the best start-up.

Selection criteria: Technology (fit to the open call focus), go to market feasibility, market potential, impact to the society (EU challenges: sustainability, digitization and resilience).

Deep tech relates to technologies that require high level of scientific knowledge to be developed and high investment to be transformed into products or services that can reach global markets, having a large impact in society. The big challenge of deep tech start-ups is to cross the bridge from science to innovation.
