DEEP TECH

Deep Tech refers to technologies with high entry barriers that require a high level of scientific knowledge to be developed and a high investment to become products or services that can reach the global markets, with a large impact on society. The big challenges facing the Deep Tech start-ups are to cross the bridge between science and innovation and to decrease uncertainty about future returns on investments. The term Deep Tech encompasses both Deep Science and Digital Techs as main subgroups.

START-UP

Independent organisation, new or young age, with a high growth potential, aiming to create, improve and expand a scalable, innovative, technology-based product, with a high and fast growth.

PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Being a European start-up.
- 2. Being an incorporated company.
- 3. Working in Deep Tech matters, following the above definition.





SELECTION PROCESS

REGISTRATION

The interested start-ups must complete the pre-registration document through the official website of Transfiere. After this process they will have to access to the platform's private area, where they will fill out the specific form.

PRE-SELECTION PHASE

The selection committee -which includes the members of the Transfiere's advisory board for investment promotion- will select **10 start-ups**. These 10 start-ups will be announced on <u>Jan 24th</u>, <u>2023.</u>

SELECTION CRITERIA

The evaluation committee will consider the following criteria for the pre-selection of candidates:

- Scalability
- Market's viability
- Impact on society
- Proper completion of the form
- Team suitability
- Provable knowledge transfer or collaboration with research centres or universities.
- Being on a TRL 5 level or above

FINAL SELECTION OF THE WINNER

The organization will contact the selected start-ups from the 20th of January 2023, and in order to preserve the acquired benefits, the start-ups will have to confirm or dismiss prior to January 26th, 2023. In case that one of the selected companies cannot participate or does not confirm its participation before the cut-off date, the company will lose said benefits and the next best rated start-up will be contacted.

The selected companies will make their presentation in the Transfiere framework the 16th of February 2023. The specialized audience -consisted of the evaluation committee, investors, Business Angels, and corporations - will then vote for the best Deep Tech start-up of the Transfiere Forum 2023.
